MINUTES OF THE VIRTUAL MEETING OF SENNEN PARISH COUNCIL HELD VIA ZOOM ON FRIDAY 3RD JULY 2020 AT 7.00PM.

21-1 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies had been received from Councillors Mr D Angove and Mr A Rowe.

21-2 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest.

21-3 DISPENSATION APPLICATIONS

No applications had been received.

21-4 INFORMATION AND COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

No members of the public were present.

21-5 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on 3rd April 2020 having been circulated, it was resolved that they should be signed as a true and correct record.

21-6 PUBLIC TOILETS

- It was reported that hand sanitisers and new signage had been put in the multi-user in alignment with the risk assessment that had been carried out. One wallgate had also been taped off to prevent cross-contamination.
- The Chairman asked whether councillors felt that more of the toilets should be opened but the general feeling was to leave them as they were for the present.
- There were concerns that the toilets at St Just and Pendeen were being refurbished by Cornwall Council prior to them being handed over to St Just Town Council. The feelings of councillors were that Sennen Parish Council should be afforded the same courtesy. Councillor Mrs Hawkins offered to pursue this matter.

21-7 PLANNING

- **Planning Applications**
 - PA20/04525 - Mr And Mrs Dominic And Martha Lay - To rebuild existing adjoining outbuildings to make two additional family bedrooms, a living room and bathroom at Sunny Bank Cottage, A30 From Mayon Green To Junction B3306, Sennen. It was agreed not to offer any objections.
- **Decisions and Other**
 - A list of decisions had been sent to the councillors.
 - Councillor Mrs Hawkins informed members that Planning Committee meetings were being held online and did not seem to be any less democratic than usual.
 - The matter of the glamping site at Trevescan was raised. Councillor Mrs Hawkins said that she had checked this site and the leisure facilities were part of the permission granted in 2003. Councillor Mrs Hawkins would check this and send it to the clerk who would forward it to councillors.

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21-8 FOOTPATHS AND HIGHWAYS

- It was reported that the bridges in the valley still awaited repair.
- There were comments that now the weedspraying had been carried out, some of the paths now looked untidy especially from Seaview Hill to the roundabout. It was decided that a request to have the soil removed should be put to Highways.
- The footpath from Mayon Farm to Parkers Moor required trimming. The clerk would contact the landowner.
- The contractor had carried out the work as per the map and no extras. There was a request that the tarmac paths be sprayed to keep the weeds down. The clerk was asked to request a price for this work. Councillor A Tonkin would confirm the exact paths to the clerk.

21-9 FINANCE

- Payments totalling £2830.37 from the Parish Council account were agreed.
- The Receipts and Payments Account for 2019/20 was presented and accepted.
- The Annual Governance Statement 2019/20 was agreed for signing.
- The Accounting Statements 2019/20 was agreed for signing.
