MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SENNEN PARISH COUNCIL HELD IN THE CHURCHTOWN VILLAGE HALL, SENNEN ON FRIDAY 6TH APRIL 2018 AT 7.00PM.

PRESENT

18-160 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Councillors Mr A Thomas and Mr T Gwennap.

18-161 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillors Mr A Thomas, Mr A Semmens and Mr M Gwennap declared an interest in any discussion about Sennen Recreation Centre but remained so that information could be provided.

18-162 DISPENSATION APPLICATIONS

No applications had been received.

18-163 INFORMATION AND COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Several members of the public spoke on the matter of the trustees of the Sennen Recreation Centre. A former trustee asked whether her name had still been on the list of trustees before the building was registered with the Land Registry and she was told that it had been but, once the Deed of Appointment for a new trustee had been prepared by the solicitor, this would be corrected with the Land Registry. Extracts from the Parish Council minutes of April and May 2009 were read out by one of the previous trustees when the Parish Council had initially resolved to accept responsibility for the building. He said that they had not been contacted since then but the last document that they had signed was the document to confirm that they had been trustees. It was also pointed out that the fourth trustee should have been appointed by now. The names in which the building had been registered was queried. The Chairman read the name from the document – Sennen Institute, Sennen Cove.

18-164 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on 9th March 2018 having been circulated and a correction made to Minute 18-165, it was resolved that they should be signed as a true and correct record.

18-165 SENNEN RECREATION CENTRE

It was felt that this matter had been discussed at length earlier.

Three members of the public left the meeting.

It was agreed that the argument about the trustees was nothing to do with the Parish Council because the history showed that the matter had been moved out of the Parish Council's responsibility so at the next meeting it would be resolved that the matter should not be discussed any further.

18-166 POLICE INFORMATION

- Police report – One crime had been reported in January; a crime of anti-social behaviour had been reported which appeared to be around the harbour car park.
- Police Liaison Group, Tuesday 24th April 2018 - Councillor C Angove agreed to try to attend.

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- Councillor Advocate Scheme and Seminar Invitation – Information had been received about a scheme that was being set up by the office of the Police and Crime Commissioner. This was noted but no action would be taken.

18-167 BEACH CAR PARK TOILETS

The Chairman informed members that all the work had been carried out except that the hand-dryers still needed attention. It was agreed that Councillors Mr A Thomas and Mr C Angove should be thanked for getting everything up and running.

18-168 PLAYGROUND

Councillor Mr D Angove reported that he had purchased the materials for repairing the seats in the teen shelter and that, along with Councillors Mr C Angove and Mr A Thomas, would be soon carrying out the work.

18-169 PLANNING

- **Plans**
 - PA18/02288 – Mr and Mrs Noon - Replacement dwelling at Myrio, Sennen Cove. It was agreed to strongly object, commenting that it was not in keeping and was overdevelopment in the AONB.
- **Decisions and Appeals**
 - A list of decisions was read to councillors.
- **Neighbourhood Development Plan**

The public meeting would be on Wednesday 11th April 2018 at 7.45pm in Churchtown Village Hall. Councillor Mr C McClary informed members that he had distributed the information about the public meeting.

18-170 FOOTPATHS AND HIGHWAYS

- It was reported that Cove Hill was now really bad and that the road surface was breaking up. It was thought that this should be reported to Steve Bailey.
- Councillors were told that any road defects should be reported on Cornwall Council's website.
- The clerk had received two enquiries about the footpath cutting and it was agreed that she could contact the Chairman to agree on any tenders that she received.

18-171 FINANCE

- Payments totalling £1045.59 from the Parish Council account and £120.00 from the Burial Committee account were agreed.
- Cornwall ALC Invitation to Subscribe for 2018-19 – It was agreed not to subscribe.

18-172 REPORTS FROM COUNCILLORS AND CORRESPONDENCE

- Cornwall Council re Pop-Up Trade Concessions – The previous successful bid had been withdrawn so information had been received about the replacement bid. This was noted.
