MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SENNEN PARISH COUNCIL HELD IN THE CHURCHTOWN VILLAGE HALL, SENNEN ON FRIDAY 2nd AUGUST 2019 AT 7.00PM.

PRESENT

20-51 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Councillors Mr A Tonkin, Mr T Gwennap, Mr A Rowe, Mr A Semmens and Mr M Gwennap.

20-52 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest.

20-53 DISPENSATION APPLICATIONS

No applications had been received.

20-54 INFORMATION AND COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

- The Head Teacher of Sennen School informed members that the solicitors were waiting for a plan of the area and that there was a hope that the playground could be covered by the school insurance in daylight hours but they were looking for somebody to lock and unlock the gates, in which case the playground would be open the following week.

20-55 PLANNING

- **Planning Applications**
 - PA19/04885 – Mr T O’Neill - Conversion of barn to form dwelling and associated works (resubmission of refused application PA18/05807) at Barn North West Of The Dwelling 'Cape Cornwall', Sennen. It was agreed not to offer any objections.

Two members of the public left the meeting.

- PA19/05426 – Heritage GB - Change of use to holiday let and alterations at Greeb Cottage, Sennen. It was agreed not to offer any objections.
- PA19/05435 – Heritage GB - Listed Building Consent: Change of use and alterations at Greeb Farm, Sennen. It was agreed not to offer any objections.

- **Decisions and Appeals**

- A list of decisions was read to the councillors.

20-56 FINANCE

- Payments totalling £5936.53 from the Parish Council account were agreed. It was pointed out at this point that one of the cleaners was carrying out an extremely poor job and that this matter needed sorting out.
- Although three parties had been asked to quote for replacing the flushes at the toilet facility, only two had replied with prices of £1480.18 and £2336.00. As both could do the work in the near future, it was agreed to accept the lower price.
- It now seemed that only the manufacturers of the wallgates could repair them and it would cost £600. However, it would then be possible to take out a contract for future repairs which also meant that they would be serviced twice a year. It was agreed to accept both the repair price and the service contract.
